

SHINE Humanity is a 501c3 organization based out of Irvine, CA.

Founded in 2009, our vision and mission states that: *together we can give a chance at a better life by providing effective and empathetic primary healthcare to the under privileged.*

We currently have **9 established clinics and 4 upcoming ones**. Most are located in interior Sindh, including in:

- Gharo
- Mirpur Sakro
- Sajjawal
- Chilya

Since our inception we have impacted the lives of **1.2 million** beneficiaries

To better serve our patients, we are running a number of programs in partnership with different organizations.

- Diabetes, Hypertension and Hyperlipidemia
- Hepatitis
- Malaria
- Asthma/COPD Management
- Community Outreach
- Panni Project – Installation of RO Plants

We are one of the first primary health providers in Pakistan to have a **very comprehensive EMR** in place, allowing us to use technology to tailor our programs. We are digitizing ALL our facilities and using telemedicine to provide technology driven health care services to under-served communities.

SHINE started off as a Disaster Relief Organization and played a very significant role in the rehabilitation process after 2005 earthquake in Pakistan. We were actively involved in the 2010 flood relief efforts in Pakistan and in the aftermath of the Tsunami in Japan.

Over all our disaster Relief efforts have impacted more than 400,000 lives since 2009.

We set up medical missions in:

- Haiti, post-earthquake – 2010
- Cox's Bazaar Bangladesh - Rohingya Refugees - 2018
- At the invitation of the Pakistan Army, a 4-day medical camp in Gilgit Baltistan - 2019

Using our Disaster Relief experience in the past we are now launching our:

## Flood Relief Action Plan 2022

Because of our presence in interior Sindh already, we are uniquely positioned to implement any planned activities quickly and effectively.

We will be setting up **multiple Medical Camps for a period of 6 months**, in close proximity to the displaced flood affected population.

Our first camp was up and running on the 30th of August. This and subsequent camps will have fully designated teams, comprising of a Physician, Pharmacist, dispenser, nurse and medical volunteers to run the camp and manage the large influx of people expected.

We are anticipating a high probability of malaria, dengue, dog and snake bites as well other waterborne diseases like typhoid and dysentery along with gastric and dermatological issues. These will be given priority in our medical protocol.

With recent funding, we are adding **a well-equipped Container clinic on wheels** as part of our relief efforts. This will allow us to penetrate further into flood affected areas.

Our auxiliary services will include:

- Dry Food Rations in partnership with Karachi Relief Trust.
- RUTF ( Ready-to-use Therapeutic Food ) packets, in collaboration with Trust for Malnutrition and Stunted Growth based out of Canada
- Water Purification Tablets

We will, of course, adapt to the needs as they arise and continue to learn from our successes and challenges.
