In 2018, SHINE Humanity Pakistan undertook a number of initiatives and partnerships with organizations with a common goal of serving the disenfranchised communities.

Furthermore, our youth group has been engaging schools and colleges with health awareness and funding their endeavours with campus donation drives. SHINE Humanity Pakistan has become Zakat compliant and is eligible for Zakat.

Additionally, SHINE Humanity Pakistan initiated a Telemedicine Clinic, in collaboration with Sehat Kahani further inside interior Sind.

## **PARTNERSHIPS**

### **GOAL:**

To further our mission of reaching out and impacting the lives of as many people in the rural communities in Pakistan.

### **IMPACT**

SHINE Humanity Pakistan has formed new partnerships with organizations in 2018, furthering our goal of providing primary healthcare to the underserved. Some partnerships were renewed by diversifying our partnership goals.

#### **1. SEHAT KAHANI**

With a mission to utilize ever-changing technology to surpass sociocultural and economical barriers that dissuade female health professionals from participating in the medical workforce, Sehat Kahani provides online, telemedicine capabilities in SHINE Humanity Pakistan's clinic in Tando Hyder.

Our telemedicine clinic is very well received by the community, where it operates 3 hours daily.

#### **2. HUSSAINI BLOODBANK & LABORATORIES**

SHINE Humanity Pakistan and Hussaini Blood bank signed a MoU allowing presence of a Lab Technician at our Gharo clinic during work hours to collect blood samples for Lab tests at discounted rates.

The technician would transport the blood work to Hussain labs on a daily basis for reports.

### **3. SINA**

SHINE Humanity Pakistan and SINA partnered to start a SHINE/SINA Rural Healthcare program, with a mission to provide access to quality primary health care in remote rural areas. The aim of this program was to provide:

- i. Training for Physician Extenders to support Physicians
- ii. Opening small clinics in rural area where there would be 1 Physician and 3 supporting Physician Extenders
- iii. Using Telemedicine to connect rural patients with Specialists.

Training of Lady Health workers/Midwives as Physicians extenders was initiated in Kohi Goth Training Hospital

#### **4. Youth Program**

##### **GOAL:**

To have a dynamic group of young medical students become ambassadors of SHINE Humanity Pakistan amongst the youth.

##### **IMPACT:**

The SHINE Humanity Youth Board, founded and run by Dr. Shahzeb Najam, has been committed to advancing SHINE's agenda since its inception in 2017. They achieved the following milestones in 2018:

- Conducted fundraising campaigns at some of the leading schools in Karachi and publicised SHINE Humanity's mission and accomplishments.
- Installed donation boxes in those schools and the proceedings were submitted to SHINE Humanity's bank account.
- Built a diverse network of over 5000+ followers on social media.
- Aided in a workshop in neonatal resuscitation for hospital staff, as part of SHINE's Helping Babies Breath initiative.

## **5. MOBILE CLINIC**

### **GOAL:**

To provide primary health care to communities with mobility issues.

### **IMPACT:**

SHINE Humanity Pakistan being committed to providing health care to all individuals partnered with Fauji Wind Energy to bring its clinic to coastal communities with limited access to transport and mobility.

From our hub in Gharo, SHINE Humanity Paksitan has continued to serve villages in Kuthi Kun area in 2018. The weekly clinics are maintained with a steady flow of patients.

In 2018, 5000 villagers were the recipients of care in these operations as a result.

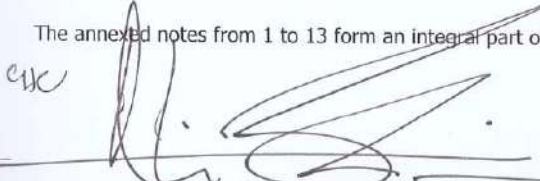
